COMPETITION INFORMATION

1A. Competition

The Championships will follow the latest version of the GAMMA Rules & Regulations for International Competitions.

The competition will be managed by GAMMA officials. The team of officials includes appointed International Technical Officials (ITOs) who will work under the leadership of the Technical Delegate (TD).

Medals will be distributed to the first four athletes of each weight category (1 Gold, 1 Silver, 2 Bronze). To ensure the competitiveness of our championships, each weight category must have at least two (2) athletes registered and weighed-in to take place. Athletes acknowledge that after the weigh-ins there may be less than two (2) athletes in a category, in which case there will be no bout and no medal given. Athletes in that situation will be offered the chance to compete in the next applicable weight category (only one (1) weight category higher than initially entered) subject to safety and the minimum number of entries.

- The Official Tournament Draw will be conducted by Sportdata through an electronic draw.
- It is mandatory for all participating athletes to wear the official competition gloves, shin pads, rashguards and shorts which will be provided by GAMMA. Athletes will receive either blue or red gear according to the draw. The gear for will be distributed on 16 June 2025. Only one (1) team representative is needed to collect the gear.
- For the World Championships, all age categories under U14 will compete on MMA tatamis. For all the categories above that age, they will compete in MMA arenas.

1C. Registration

Participation Eligibility

Participating Federations must be members of GAMMA.

Each National Federation is invited to register up to two (2) athletes in each weight category. All registrations must be done through GAMMA's database [here](#). The Step-by-step **Registration Process** can be found in **Appendix 1** and the **Photo Requirements** for registration can be found in **Appendix 2**.

- All registered team members must report for registration with their passports.
- The participation fee is 150 EUR per discipline. Payment is the final step of the registration process. Once completed, the athlete will be moved from the waiting list to the official entry list, which is publicly visible.
- Athletes participating in the competition must hold the nationality of the country they represent and comply with all GAMMA rules and regulations.
- All athletes must submit **The Participation Form** two (2) weeks prior to the competition. The form can be filled in [here](#). This form includes the Athlete's Acknowledgement & Agreement form, the Medical Liability Waiver, Release of Liability and the Code of Conduct.
- All participants are requested to get their own travel and medical insurance.
- Neither the Organising Committee nor GAMMA (nor any of its officials and members) will be liable or responsible for any personal injury nor for any loss of damage to your property arising out of your participation and travelling in connection with this tournament.

The closing date for complete registration (including payment) is 1 May 2025.

Age Eligibility

Age limits are based on the athlete's age as of 16 June 2025, the official registration date.

There is no maximum age limit for seniors. However, athletes over the age of 40 may be required to provide additional medical documents to confirm their fitness to compete.

Team Personnel

Team Delegation can have the following number of Team Personnel:

- 1 Team Manager
- 1 Team Medic
- 1 Physiotherapist
- 1 Media Officer
- No limit on number of coaches.

Each athlete may be accompanied to the competition area by up to two (2) coaches. However, only one (1) may enter the competition area.

The **Code of Conduct** including Release of Liability must be signed by all team members. Click [here](#) to fill in the form.

1D. Visa & Entry Requirements

In **Appendix 3** you can find the visa overview by country, dated 8 april 2025. Always verify the latest visa requirements for your country before travelling.

1E. Transportation

International Airport

There are two (2) international airports for official arrivals in São Paulo,

1. Guarulhos (GRU)
2. Viracopos (VCP)

The cost of airport transportation is \$20 per person per journey. Fill in **Appendix 4: Travel Request Form** to request airport transportation. This form must be submitted to idtcema@gmail.com with travel@gamma-sport.org in CC.

Transportation is only provided between the two international airports and official hotels on arrival (15 - 16 June) and departure (23 June). A confirmation email upon successful submission will be sent after the deadline.

The deadline to submit the Travel Request Form is 8 May 2025.

Local Transportation

Local airport transportation will be provided and covered for all teams who stay at the official accommodation and submit their complete travel information to idtcema@gmail.com with travel@gamma-sport.org in CC no later than 15 May 2025. The form can be downloaded [here](#).

Transportation for these teams will also be provided to and from the official hotels and the competition venue on the days of competition.

1F. Accommodation

Due to limited capacity, no single hotel in São Paulo can accommodate all teams. Therefore, a selection of official hotels has been listed in **Appendix 5: List of Official Hotels**.

To secure your accommodation, teams are required to submit their preferences and pay the associated additional costs in advance (**payment deadline 25 May**). For hotel reservation please submit the **Hotel Reservation Form** that can be found in **Appendix 6** and send it to idtcema@gmail.com. While teams may indicate their preferred hotel, assignments will be made based on availability. Early submission increases the likelihood of securing your top choice. If preferences are not available or not submitted in time, the LOC will assign hotels according to your selected category: **economy, midscale, or luxury**.

For the Senior Competition, accommodation for eight (8) nights (15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 June) including breakfast and dinner will be covered for athletes and coaches according to the following numbers:

- 1 athlete / 0 coaches
- 2-8 athletes / 1 coach / 1 NF President
- 9-15 athletes / 2 coaches / 1 NF President

Accommodation covered by GAMMA may be twin/ double rooms.

Accommodation full board will only be covered for Technical Officials (referees and judges) that are **officially invited by GAMMA**. For other Technical Officials, the **National Federation is responsible for the costs**.

For outside the above quota, the costs per person per night are:

This includes full board accommodation and local transportation as stated in 1E (excl. airport transportation). In addition, you will also have full access to the Wet 'n Wild Waterpark.

NOTE:

If any team decides not to stay in the official hotel booked through IDT-CEMA, they will be responsible for arranging their own daily transportation. Entry tickets for Wet 'n Wild Waterpark/ competition venue are USD 17.50 (R\$ 100) a day. These costs need to be worn by the teams themselves.

1G. Competition Venue

The GAMMA World Championships 2025 shall be hosted in the **Wet 'n Wild** Waterpark in Itupeva. For more information, see **Appendix 7**.



1H. Accreditation

Accreditation will take place on 16 June.

Each Team delegation can appoint a maximum of two (2) people to attend the Accreditation check. GAMMA recommends each team to send their Team Manager and/or Head Coach.

Each Team Delegation's representatives will have a 10-minute appointment with GAMMA officials to confirm the entry list of their delegation, the spelling of athletes' names, and the weight category. During this process, there will also be checked if all team members filled in the forms.

All Team Delegation members who are registered for the event through Sportdata within the deadline will receive their accreditations on site after the accommodation payment has been approved by GAMMA.

1I. Weigh-Ins & Hydrated Weight Testing

All athletes will need to weigh-in by 12:00pm on 16 June 2025. This weigh-in will be valid for the first day of the competition on 17 June. Thereafter, athletes who qualify to compete in the next round(s), must weigh-in every morning of that day.

Senior athletes may be selected for hydrated weight testing based on random sampling.

Athletes selected for hydration testing must pass the test before proceeding to the official weigh-ins.

Under the guidance of a doctor, the technician and doctor will perform a test of the athlete's urine sample to ensure that the athlete is hydrated (hydrated = urine specific gravity ≤ 1.0250). The athlete's weight must be within the limits.

1J. Doping Control

Doping-free Tournament

GAMMA has a zero-tolerance policy towards doping in sport and any other form competition manipulation. Athletes are bound and must comply with the [GAMMA Anti-doping rules](#) which are compliant with the World Anti-Doping Code.

Doping Controls

In-competition doping testing during the tournament will be carried out. As per the WADA Code, athletes and athlete support personnel can be selected for doping testing during the championships. This will be done at random according to the International standard procedure. Tests will be managed by the International Testing Agency (ITA).

*Athlete Support Personnel is defined as: Any coach, trainer, manager, agent, team staff, official, medical, paramedical personnel, parent or any other person working with, treating or assisting an athlete participating in or preparing for the competition.

To ensure independence, the ITA or its recognized national partner will perform the sample collection and conduct laboratory analysis in accordance with the International Standard for Testing, the [International Standard for Laboratories and the 2025 Prohibited List](#).

During the period of the tournament, athletes can be tested at any time or place with a blood or urine sample with no prior notice. It is each athlete's responsibility to ensure that no prohibited substance enters his or her body.

GAMMA's anti-doping program is not limited to doping controls, it also includes activities like Risk Assessment, management of [Therapeutic Use Exemptions \(TUEs\)](#) for international-level athletes, Results Management, and Education.

1K. Medical Care

Member Federations need to ensure that all their athletes are covered with hospitalization insurance for Brazil. Access to an Ambulance will be available and access to the local hospital will be available 24/7 during the tournament period if needed.

Medical checks

Medical checks will be carried out upon arrival, pre-bout and post bout. Decisions of the event appointed medical doctor are final.

All athletes must submit the Medical Questionnaire, which is included in the Participation Form (see 1C).

1L. Insurance

All participants are requested to get their own travel and medical insurance.

Neither the Organising Committee nor GAMMA (nor any of its officials and members) will be liable for or responsible for any personal injury nor for any loss of damage to your property arising out of your participation and travelling in connection with this tournament.

1M. Opening & Closing Ceremony

There will be a parade of participating delegations on the first day of the competition (16 June).

Federation representatives could be invited up on stage during the award ceremony to present medals to the podium finishers. As such, they should be dressed appropriately.

Note: Official flags provided or approved by GAMMA will be allowed to be used by the athletes during the award ceremony.

Athletes are not allowed to wear any form of headgear on the podium. Athletes are only allowed to wear their national team attire for the award ceremony.

The U18 categories are only in MMA. We accept athletes with or without a professional record.</p>

Running trails, bike paths, and yoga and capoeira sessions let locals and visitors alike keep fit, while a clutch of museums and galleries — such as the museums of Modern and Contemporary Art, all designed by master Brazilian architect Oscar Niemeyer — gives the brain a good workout. The impressive Museu Afro Brasil and fiery Auditório Ibirapuera are two of the park's treasures.



3. Pinacoteca do Estado de São Paulo

Pinacoteca is a museum of visual arts, with emphasis on Brazilian production since the nineteenth century. It belongs to the São Paulo State Secretariat of Culture. It was founded in 1905 by the State Government of São Paulo and it is the oldest art museum in the city. It is installed in the old building of the Arts and Crafts College, designed in the late nineteenth century by the architect Ramos de Azevedo. In the 1990's it underwent an extensive renovation with the architect Paulo Mendes da Rocha's project. Pinacoteca hosts about thirty exhibitions and receives about 450,000 visitors yearly. The museum's main focus is to promote to general public a better experience with visual arts with its collection, building and historical relevance.

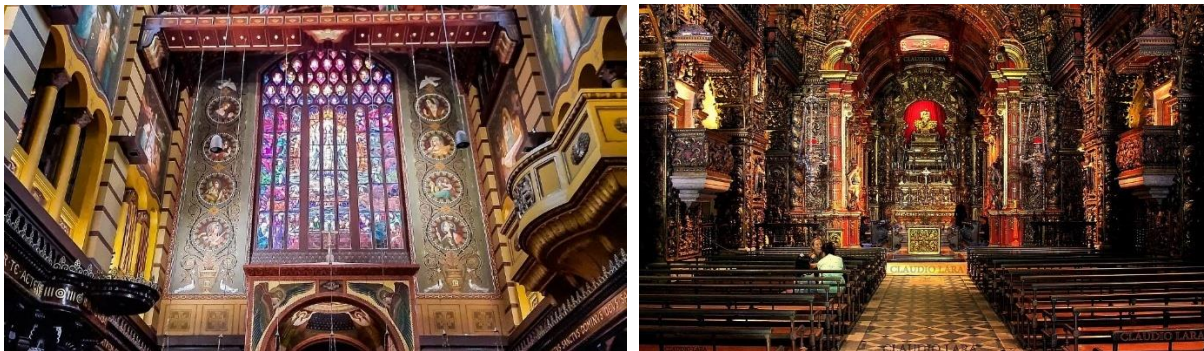
5. Mercado Municipal de São Paulo

Housed in a stunning example of eclectic industrial architecture, the Mercado Municipal de São Paulo — nicknamed the Mercadão — has thousands of food items on offer, literally from soup to nuts. Lush tropical and temperate fruits from every season, choice cuts of meats and fish, and hearty prepared foods, such as the renowned and enormous mortadella (bologna) sandwich, complete the market's catalog of wares, all for sale in a boisterous, welcoming atmosphere. The surrounding area can be a bit sketchy, but the sights and flavors more than make up for the journey downtown.



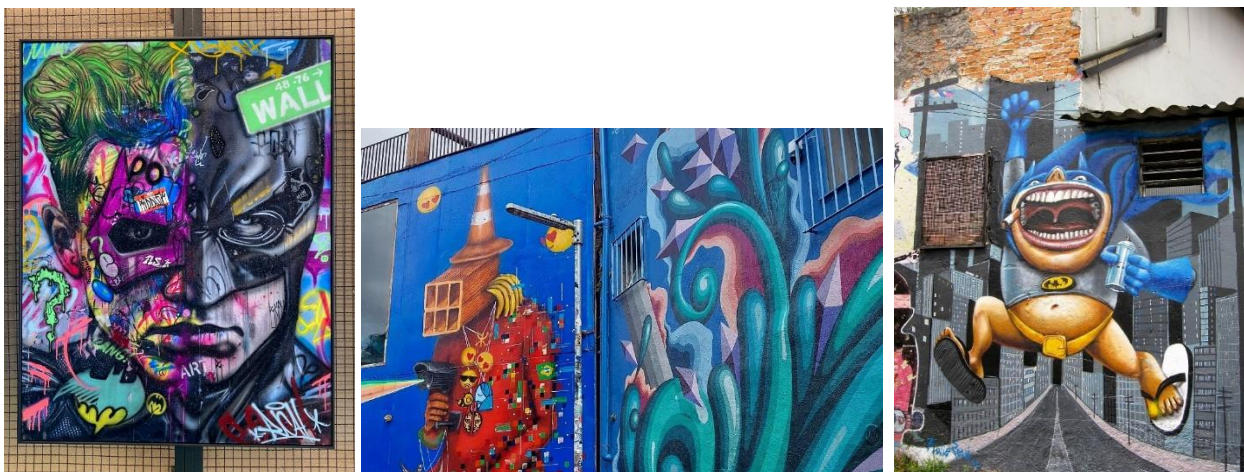

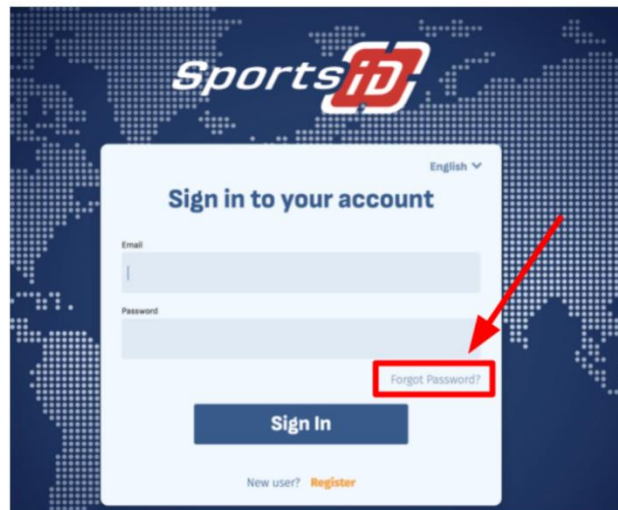

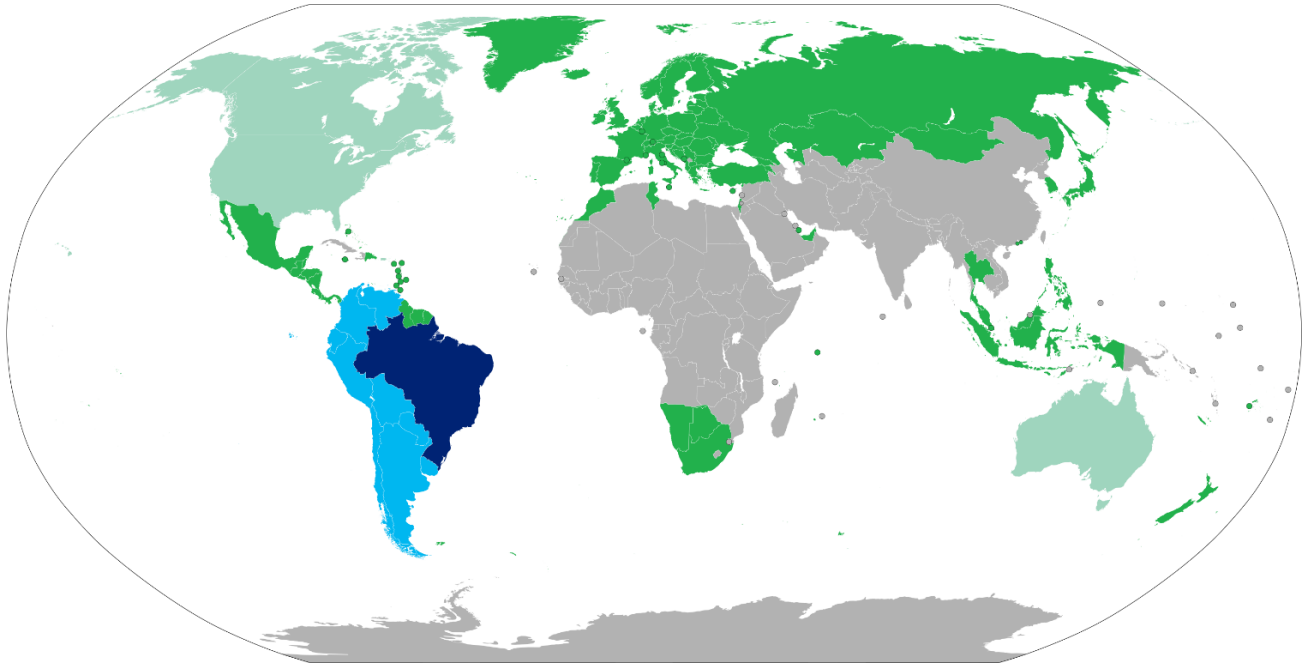
